

Tahunanui Pathways – Stage 2 Complete



With your input, Nelson City Council has been able to design and build the Tahunanui Pathways project to create a safe and efficient route for cyclists and pedestrians in Tahunanui.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while the work was underway, we are looking forward to seeing families, schoolkids and the local community enjoy this new cycleway on your street.



Information for cycleway users:

- Keep left, slow down, obey all signage
- Warn other users with your bell or a greeting
- Stopped for a chat? Move to the side of the path



Information for Vehicles:

- Slow down when crossing the cycleway
- Give way to cyclists and pedestrians on the adjacent footpath and cycleway
- Parking on the cycleway is against the law



Use driveways adjacent to the cycleway carefully:

- Slow down
- Check in both directions
- Be prepared to stop if required
- All bins are to be placed on the kerbside as normal

The new cycleway down Muritai Street is for bikes and other modes of active transport. Please do not drive down or park in the cycleway. Parking is still available on the western side of Muritai Street.
