Reviewing Locking Street – Residents

In December we sent a letter to residents and property owners providing a summary of feedback we had received from many of you about the challenges on Locking Street. We also put forward some suggestions for solutions that could potentially reduce some of those challenges.

Overall, we are working to make Locking Street safer for all users.

We would like to provide the residents and property owners of Locking Street with the opportunity to let us know face to face what solutions you think could work on your street.

We are proposing to set-up a marquee at the top end of Locking Street (on the grass verge outside 75 Kawai Street), where residents can drop by and have a chat.

There will be a few staff there, so we are happy to walk down the street with you to understand what solutions you believe could improve the safety on Locking Street.

We plan to do this on Wednesday 24 February 2021, from 4:30pm to 6:30pm. If the weather doesn't play ball then we will look to do this the following Wednesday (3 March 2021).

As previously mentioned some of the key challenges from previous feedback received included:

- Excessive speed at the lower end of Locking Street
- Concerns regarding the lack of space for all road users, specifically pedestrians and cyclists alongside parked cars and moving vehicles.
- Concerns have been amplified by the closure of Hampden Street West.

We look forward to seeing you on Wednesday 24 February.
