PROGRESS UPDATE

Despite a few wet days, work continues to progress on the new shared path alongside Poorman Valley Stream, between Main Rd Stoke and Neale Avenue. The new retaining walls to support the pathway are nearing completion. The ground base for the pathway has been prepared and is now ready for the concrete to be poured. New kerb and channel, as well as a reconstructed asphalt pathway, have also been completed on the Main Rd Stoke section of the project.

Work is planned to be completed in June, depending on the weather over the coming weeks.
