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HAVEN ROAD STORMWATER REALIGNMENT PROJECT WORK

Work is about to start on improving the way our stormwater is managed in the Fountain Place stormwater catchment. The current pipes are nearing the end of their useful life, and need to be upgraded.

These pipes currently run through private land, so part of the upgrade will involve realigning the pipes so they pass through public land.

Council has completed investigation work and we have worked out the best route for the new stormwater pipe.

This will be installed within the central grass berm on Haven Road. It will cross both the state highway and an identified heritage sea wall. Keep an eye on our Shape Nelson website for updates and some historical information.

Further details of the work are shown over the page. We are looking to start this work in the week beginning 18 October 2021, through to March 2022 (weather dependent).

Property and business access will be maintained at all times.

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STORMWATER INSTALLATION

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

• Laying a 1200mm diameter stormwater main from Saltwater Creek to part way up Vickerman Street, where it will reduce in size to a 600mm diameter pipe.

WHY ARE WE DOING IT?

• To replace aging pipework in our stormwater network.

DURATION:

• 21 weeks (inclusive of a 3 week Christmas break), effectively from 18 October 2021 to March 2022 (weather dependant).

TRAFFIC CONDITIONS:

 Minimal impact during work in the grass berm. 30km/hr speed restriction and detours (of through traffic) will be in place during works on road crossings. See maps below for details of the detour routes.
