

Consultation on proposed changes to Urban Environments Bylaw 2015

Nelson City Council has reviewed its Urban Environments Bylaw 2015 (No.225) and proposes to amend it. The Urban Environments Bylaw covers the keeping of animals, management of public health, safety and nuisance, trading in public places, control of alcohol in public places, management of reserves, and burial and cremations.

Council would like to know what you think of the proposed changes and the draft bylaw.
