

PROJECT UPDATE

HASTINGS STREET – STAGE 1

Stage 1 of the Hastings St infrastructure upgrade will be starting from Monday 14 February 2022. A full road closure (represented as red in the picture below) will be in place between the current Spotlight entrance and St Vincent St. The remainder of Hastings St and Pioneer Crescent will be open to residents only (represented as orange in the picture below).



Upcoming Construction Activities:

- Sewer Manhole Installation within St Vincent St.
- Power and communication trenching along the berm (grassed area) of Hastings St. This will run the length of Hastings Street and will have an impact on resident's driveways.

Key information:

- Duration – This work will run from 14 February through March 2022.
- Resident access to Hastings St and Pioneer Crescent will be via Washington Road only.
- There will be no access to Spotlight via Hastings St (access will be off St Vincent Street).
- While the power and communication trenching blocks access to driveways, residents are asked to temporarily park elsewhere. A carpark within Pioneer Park (represented as green in the picture above) has been provided as an alternate parking option for residents.
- Residents are asked to take care while driving or walking past the power and communication trench construction area.
- Residents are asked to keep the grass berm along Hastings St clear during the construction works.
