Road Safety Improvements – Stansell Avenue

In June 2022, Nelson City Council asked for feedback on a range of road safety and traffic calming measures proposed between 56 Stansell Avenue and Marie Street (including lower Tosswill Road and Chamberlain Street). These measures included speed humps, no stopping lines, and stop signs. Wide support from the community allowed us to progress to and complete design, and we will commence construction on these measures in the first half of 2023.

It became evident while reading through earlier feedback that there was a desire by several residents along Stansell Avenue to extend the traffic calming measures further north towards Moana Avenue. Specifically, it was requested that additional speed humps be included in this stretch of roadway.

Enclosed with this letter is a plan of proposed locations for additional speed humps. We are seeking feedback to see if these locations have support from the community along Stansell Avenue. Upon completion of consultation, any additional locations that are supported will be included into the construction programme.
