WHAT WHEN TRAFFIC

**Collingwood St and Manuka St Sewer Renewal
Construction – 17 April to end of June 2023
Speed Restriction, One Way Traffic, Parking
Restriction**



WHAT ARE WE DOING?

- Sections of sewer pipe in Collingwood Street (approx. 200 metres) and Manuka Street (approx. 80 metres) are now over 100 years old. The pipes are earthenware (clay) and inspections have shown they need to be replaced before they pose a risk to the environment. We will be replacing these pipes before it becomes urgent.
- We will also take the opportunity to replace the sewer laterals – the pipes that connect the main sewer pipe to the property boundary.

DURATION:

- Construction is scheduled to begin in the week starting 17 April 2023. It will take approximately 10 – 12 weeks to complete (weather dependent).

TRAFFIC CONDITIONS:

- To make sure our contractors can operate safely, lane closures are needed. Traffic management will include a one-way southbound section on Collingwood Street. A detour will be in place to travel north on Collingwood Street via Trafalgar Street South, Trafalgar Square and Nile Street.
- Speed restrictions and parking restrictions will be in place.
