

# NRSBU Wastewater Pipe Duplication Project



## Section Six – Mid June to November

The wastewater pipe along Elms Street is being upgraded. Ching Contracting Ltd is the contractor appointed to complete the work, and will be liaising with businesses in the area before work gets underway. This work will have an impact on traffic.

## Works so far

This is a multistage wastewater project for Nelson Regional Sewerage Business Unit (NRSBU). We have completed Section 10 and are now starting sections 5 to 7.

## Why are we upgrading services?

This project will improve the resilience of the sewer network. A secondary sewer main is being installed around the Waimea inlet from the Beach Road pump station in Richmond to Monaco.

## Upcoming works

Section 6 includes Kotua Place and Elms Street.

This work will start on 19 June 2023. It is expected to take 6 months to complete.

There will not be any detours; however, there will be some traffic flow restrictions, as you can view from the map below.

- The proposed work areas will be a combination of coned 2-way traffic flows, and lane closures where traffic will be restricted to a single lane with priority give way or stop/go traffic control where required
- A speed restriction of 30km/hr will be in place the proposed work zone.
