BROOK STREAM – CONCRETE WALL REPAIR

During the August 2022 weather event some of Nelson's rivers and streams suffered stream bank or stream bed erosion. We need to remediate some of these areas to reduce the chance of the river flooding again and damaging Council assets and/or private property.

We have identified some areas of the concrete wall along Tasman Street that require repair. This will be done by placing rock and gravel.

This work will occur from Monday 4 December 2023. It is likely to take approximately 1 week to complete (weather dependent). Due to the supply of rock being required to repair this wall, a Stop/GO will be required at the commencement of the project and should only last for 1 hour. Due to the bus lane, this will have to occur after 730pm at night.

The approximate area of repair is shown in Figure 1 below.
