## **BROOK STREAM - WILLOW WALK**

During the August 2022 weather event some of Nelson's rivers and streams suffered stream bank or stream bed erosion. We need to remediate some of these areas to reduce the chance of the river flooding again and damaging Council assets and/or private property.

We have identified some damaged areas along Willow Walk (between Bronte Street and Manuka Street). The existing rock armouring (rocks to protect the riverbank) needs to be repaired as a high priority. The rock required for the repairs will be transported along Willow Walk from Bronte St. This work will occur from Monday 8 January 2024 and is likely to take approximately 2 weeks to complete (weather dependent). To carry out this work safely, Willow Walk will need to be closed between Manuka St and Bronte St. Alternative walking routes will be along Tasman St and Collingwood St.

The approximate areas of repair is shown in Figure 1 below.
