## **BROOK STREAM - STREAMBANK GRADING AND PLANTING**

During the August 2022 weather event some of Nelson's rivers and streams suffered stream bank or stream bed erosion, and/or were inundated with flood debris. We need to remediate some of these areas to reduce the chance of the river flooding again and further damaging Council assets and/or private property.

We have identified two high priority flood damage sites opposite 285 Brook Street. We are planning to stabilise the eroded bank by constructing a rock wall and then we will lay some natural rock in the stream bed where a wastewater pipe (that crossed the stream) has been exposed, behind 285 Brook Street. This will prevent future exposure of the wastewater pipe by slowing the flow of water through this section of the stream.

To prevent further erosion, we are planning repairs to commence on Monday 22 January 2024. The work will take around 2 weeks to complete (weather dependent).




Figure 1: Taken from Top of the South Maps.

The approximate area of repair is shown in Figure 1 below.
