Nelson City Council Private Plan Change 28 - outline Submission from Dr. Gwen Struik...July7, 2022

#### **Background** - Personal

Dr. Gwen Struik, PhD in Plant & Animal Ecology 1960.

My published research is in life history studies of forest and grassland plants and N.Z. fisheries including a Marlborough multispecies estuarine fish study 1971-2014 (43 years).

I am a founding member, (and still on committee) of a top of the South coastal watch group called Friends of Nelson Haven & Tasman Bay Inc. (FNH). We started in 1973 (49 years ago) with one objective, which was to stop Nelson City Council's plan to infill the Haven/Pararoa (bread basket). My initial submission of December 2021 includes a copy of the NCC plan. We succeeded dramatically in stopping that infilling. However, overtime the estuary of the Maitai River (Pararoa/Haven) has been one third infilled, with highway, tips, private housing and agriculture plus harbour land expansion. I believe this infilling has slowed and hopefully stopped. Since most land and coastal human activity impacts eventually on our coast FNH has been very busy and our history, annual and research reports are on our website (www.nelsonhaven.org.nz).

#### Background -in relation to Private Plan Change 28

I was delighted to see that the Sweetman report mentions the fact that sediment generated from the proposed housing development will impact the Pararoa/Haven. Despite many engineering attempts to minimize sediment flow to streams and estuaries, Nelson/Wakatu streams run dark with silt after rain. This development will be no exception. Already sediment from land have caused huge damage to the living organisms of the estuaries and further into Tasman Bay. The result is that the overfished filter feeding shellfish beds of oyster, mussels and scallops cannot regenerate and the filter feeding bryozoan beds which are a nursery for fish also cannot recover.

It is essential that Council put as little stress on our streams and coastal ecosystems.

I believe that David Attenborough, at age 93, has observed the world's ecosystems over the past 70 years and educated more people on them than anyone else on the planet. His conclusion is that

### Human survival depends on reversing the trend of the past century and especially the last 20 years of changing ecosystems from the biodiverse Wild to the monoculture Tame.

Although the Maitai and Kaka Valleys are by no means "wild" they are more biodiverse than any housing development. Even with amenity plantings of natives, the existence of housing and its infrastructure will reduce the area of water absorption, air quality and soil productivity. It is essential that we develop brown fields (already built areas) and not develop green fields.

Further Attenborough quotes: We are crossing irreversible tipping points.......Between 2020-2030 it will be the decisive decade for humanity......We can choose to disregard the disaster waiting on our doorstep, or we could change...

Nelson City Council Private Plan Change 28 - outline submission from Gwen Bray ...July 8, 2 0 22-

Gwen Bray - I have been rate payer living in central Nelson/Wakatu since 1968 (54 years). I have watched this city grow and am concerned that the present proposal is more about making money than about providing affordable, appropriate housing.

In fact, judging from the flood of ads I receive in newspapers, magasines, on radio and other media selling retirement space, it looks like there is a huge housing surplus. It is just not **appropriate** housing - or why do I receive all these ads? As a 90 year old I feel it is best for neighborhoods to be a mixture of ages. I have found that I can help neighbours with young children and I can use help with tasks I am no longer strong enough to perform.

Affordable housing relates to ability to pay and when we immigrated to Aotearoa in 1963, young families could afford a home. There was the family benefit (a government payment for each child) which could be "capitalized" i.e. forfeited in exchange for a down payment on a house. So a young family could spend money on a mortgage instead of rent and eventually own a house. I recall the highest home ownership was in Wainuiomata, described as a working class, highly Polynesian suburb of Wellington, aka "nappy valley'. Today this home ownership means you can exchange that for a retirement spot (by "reverse mortgage"), but you don't own the spot, it and any profit made from the sale is at the convenience of the owners of the retirement village so as to guarantee little or no inheritance to the next generation. So the government subsidy of the '60s ends up privatized to businesses which are more often than not foreign owned, making the donut/circular economy with money circulating round and round impossible because it bleeds to off shore or to some wealthy owner. (Around 1990 the National government abandoned the Family Benefit.) So we have a model for genuine home ownership and a model for the rich to get richer and the poor to remain homeless. In fact every "crisis" whether it is the Global Financial (GFC) or pandemic ends up with the rich getting richer by getting a bit from the millions of less well-off people.

In 1963 we immigrated to Aotearoa and bought a house convenient to work for \$8000, sold it for \$8000 and bought a 10 acre farmlet in the Moutere for \$8000, and sold it for \$8000 and bought a house in central Nelson for \$8000. The average wage at that time was just under \$2000, which means home prices were 4 times the average wage. Today the medium wage (what half the people earn) is \$70,000, so an **affordable** home needs to be 4 to 5 times that, i.e. \$350,000. It is highly unlikely that homes in the Maitai-Kaka Valley will be in that range since the object is not to house the homeless. It is most likely the object is to make money. But we have local model from our past for **affordable** housing.

I look at the houses being built in Nelson and find that a fair number are not lived in. They are built by wealthy people - often from overseas - for a summer home?, an investment?, a weekend retreat?, I don't know, but they are empty much of the year. There is a chance that if these houses were available, much of the homeless crisis could be solved.

The other thing that amazes me is the lack of two storey homes. Perhaps putting a second level to present homes would relieve the homelessness. I am advised that, that it is financially and architecturally feasible. The concept of an infinite supply of land is of another era and not a reasonable option.
