# Testival Report

### Tuku 22 at a glance:

#### **Events and Participants:**

There were 83 events held during Tuku21. Participation at events was estimated at 14,796 people.

#### **Event Hosts Contribution**

Sixteen event hosts received a total of \$21,132 from Nelson City Council's Event Host Grant Fund. The event hosts collectively contributed an estimated additional \$26,672 in kind or in monetary value to these events as match funding.

#### **Heritage Budget Spend**

Out of the Heritage Activities Programme, Council spent a total of \$??????? on the festival, including grants to event hosts, and promotion of events.

#### **Economic Value**

Tuku 22 Whakatū Heritage Month was a festival of culture that celebrated Nelson's unique stories, people and places. This year due to the impending Omicron outbreak of COVID 19 a decision was taken to "space out" the festival allowing hosts to have postponement flexibility and more planning time. This meant the festival ran not just in the usual month of April but also in May and June. This extended timeframe hugely increased participation.

Under the festival's tried and tested format, Council's role has been supporting individuals and groups to develop and coordinate their own events. These "Event Hosts" are supported with a contestable Tuku 22 grant fund and with significant marketing and promotion, both funded by Council.

Running for the month of April, May and June Tuku 22 hosted an unprecedented 96 events, including tours, workshops, talks, open days, performances and community celebrations. The programme covered cultural, natural and social history and art in the form of poetry, music, theatre, craft and digital art experiences. Attendee numbers at events are estimated at 14,796 people with a further 5,551 people estimated to attend displays and exhibits that were also part of the programme.





# Vision and Community Outcomes

Council has supported Tuku 22 Whakatū Heritage Months because it contributes to realising the vision in the Long Term Plan 2021 - 2031. It promotes Nelson's heritage and has social, cultural, and economic benefits for our community.

#### **Community Outcomes**

 Art & Artisans – there is an extraordinary depth of heritage, artists and artisan businesses here. Nelson is home to three of the oldest cultural institutions in New Zealand – the Suter Art Gallery, the Theatre Royal and the Nelson Centre for Musical Arts (Nelson School of Music).

Everyone has a favourite event memory from Tuku 22. Here are a few from Tom Ransom, the Nelson City Council Arts and Heritage Adviser who coordinated the festival:

Sadly due to being struck with COVID 19, I was unable to attend the Ngati Kuia "Pakohe Trails" walk. I heard from others how excellent it was, with kaitiaki Lewis Smith sharing his mauturanga around the use of this stone that is so special to this region and Māori. Having three iwi led events in the program was an important step forward for Tuku 22. For the fourth year running, the festivals percentage of events that represent non-European stories has grown. Looking forward to Tuku 23 I hope we see this diversity increase.

Nelson's incredibly vibrant Indonesian community created two very special events for Tuku 22. With a batik workshop, amazing food, dance and music, attendees senses were brought alive on a virtual "trip to Indonesia". My congratulations goes out to Mini Wati and her band of Indonesian families. You created a magical atmosphere, topped off with a room of us playing music together on fascinating bamboo "anglong" instruments.

Having the Antarctic Heritage Trust bring their "Sir Ed Hillary's Antarctic Hut" virtual reality experience was a definite headline event. Over 300 people "walked" into that hut in the snow from the Founders Heritage Park "portal". Such a low carbon way of experiencing that special heritage place.

Because of its extended duration, some Matariki events were part of the festival. This included the "small but beautiful" Nga Whetu O Matariki community park projections. These six light art shows featured a return of Nerys Ngaruhe's stunning whetu designs. Bringing the kaupapa to people in small neighbourhood parks where they could walk to the shows. This was I think, a subtle and respectful way of marking the season in a 100% local way.






