PROPOSED ROAD LAYOUT CHANGE- QUEBEC ROAD

Council has received a request to install yellow No-Stopping lines on the cul-de-sac of Quebec Road. This request has been made due to parked cars prohibiting residents from entering and exiting the cul-de-sac and preventing deliveries being made to residents. Parking would still be available along the main road way, where it is considerate and legal to do so.

We acknowledge that the proposed yellow lines will result in a loss of some on-street parking for residents and visitors. Therefore, we are seeking feedback on this proposal. Feedback will be presented to Elected Members at a Hearings Panel meeting, where they will decide whether to install the no-parking lines or not.
